FESTIVAL CONDUCTORS

Mary-Anne Goyder has been a music specialist with the Department of Education since 1981 and has taught in both Secondary and Primary schools. In 2007 she was awarded the inaugural 'National Award for Excellence in School Music Education-Excellence by a Teacher'. Mary-Anne delivers PD, is an adjudicator for the Children Sing Festival and won the Women of Achievement Award for 2018. She has been a conductor of the festival since 2009.

Mirelle Hopwood became interested in choral music whilst studying under a choral scholarship at Perth Modern School. Since completing a BMus (Perf) and Grad Dip Ed at WAAPA, she has gained considerable choral experience, both as a chorister and conductor, including the Giovanni Consort, St George's Baroque Consort and the WA Children's Choir. Mirelle presently teaches and directs choirs at Churchlands SHS. She has been a conductor of the festival since 2012.
